What is expected of you as a Trustee?

As an organisation committed to accessible, ethical and inclusive digital innovation, we are seeking a trustee with experience in digital production, technology or product management to join our board. Your passion for designing and developing accessible, ethical and compelling digital products and services will directly support our Innovate UK-funded programme **Pathways Not Projects**, helping us shape digital-first approaches that empower the young people and creative practitioners we work with.

Lighthouse has a long history of championing emerging talent in digital arts and culture. As a trustee, you will contribute your expertise to ensure our digital developments are user-centred, future-focused and aligned with our values. You will help us consider the ethical implications of technology, strengthen our organisational digital strategy, and ensure our programmes continue to be accessible, equitable and relevant.

In-person attendance at quarterly board meetings is encouraged to build strong working relationships with fellow trustees and the Lighthouse team (although hybrid participation can be facilitated when needed).

We expect that this position will require an investment of **4 hours per** month.

Location: A mix of online and face-to-face meetings.

Commitment: Approximately four board meetings per year, including one board strategy half-day (board meetings usually take place in person in Brighton but can also be attended online). Meetings will last a maximum of two hours, with breaks included. Food provided if in-person.

Remuneration: Voluntary. Trustee meetings are unpaid, but travel and other reasonable expenses are reimbursed where applicable.

Duration of term: A maximum duration of four years.
